The Home Repair Program offers minor repairs and modifications to homes and apartments to enable older adults to remain at home comfortably, safely, and independently.

Service activities may include but are not limited to:

- Install bathroom grab bars or other safety devices
- Handheld shower sprays
- Stair railings
- Lockboxes
- Basic home maintenance and repairs
- Gutter services
- Install and remove window air conditioning units
- Minor electrical and plumbing issues
- Small furniture assembly
- Hang shelving and pictures
- Install smoke detectors and fire extinguishers
